Why choice challenges?

- You can differentiate the process and product in which students learn and demonstrate their understanding
- Students can take ownership of their learning and tap into their creativity
- Engagement and motivation are increased as students are given autonomy

How to use this template

1. Fill in the topic, number of stars to collect, and the due date.

The aim is for students to complete this activity over an extended period of time. This could be anywhere from one week to an entire term. Just remember to keep the time period in mind when you are choosing tasks.

2. Fill in the choice challenges grid with activities for your students.

Aim to make activities worth more stars the more involved they are for students. While they may take a little bit longer, students will be rewarded for their effort.

You could also give students a time indicator for each task type. For example, a 2 star task should take 15 minutes to complete.
